

More reasons why I do not use the NIV

Last week the article was about the manuscripts that were used to translate the NIV and the slight of hand used to try to cast doubt on some passages while leaving others alone that are also not included in those old manuscripts. This article will deal with passages that are mistranslated in the NIV.

In Matthew 5:32 and 19:9 we find that a person can divorce and remarry for, “marital unfaithfulness.” The KJV states that a person can divorce their mate for the cause of “fornication” in both of these passages. There is a large and vast difference between “marital unfaithfulness” and “fornication.” A person can be unfaithful to the marriage vows in many ways and that does not make it right to divorce. The couple might need some counseling along these lines to help with the problem or problems but that does not mean they need to divorce. According to Vine’s Dictionary of New Testament Words fornication means: “(a) of illicit sexual intercourse, it stand for, or includes, adultery.” The Greek word that is translated fornication is “porneia.” The word “pornography” is derived from this word. According to the NIV, it would be ok to divorce ones mate for the reason of sickness, not taking out the trash, not taking care of the car or lawn or not doing the laundry, not cleaning the house and many other ideas that would or could come under the heading of “marital unfaithfulness.” There are persons within a marriage now using this to divorce their mates and remarry. One wonders how they will fair on the judgment day? God has clearly stated what He means, and we do not need any help to weaken it down. The translators will have to give an account for what they have caused people to believe and do as well as those who are doing. We are to know the truth! The term “marital unfaithfulness” is way too vague for something as serious as this.

The NIV will also confuse a person about when they are saved. Ephesians 1:13-14 in the NIV reads, “And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth...” You did not know that a person is saved as soon as they hear? Look carefully at that passage again. It says that a person is “included in Christ” when they hear! Ephesians 1:3 according to the NIV says, “Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.” So as soon as we hear, whether we accept or not we are included in those spiritual blessings. Not only that, but read Ephesians 1:7 in the NIV. It states, “In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace.” So if we are “included in Christ” when we hear, does that mean also that we have forgiveness of sins at the same point? Does that mean we have redemption at the point

when we hear the Gospel? They do not have to even believe according to the NIV! All we have to do is preach the Gospel to people and if they hear it they are saved. Is that not what all those things mean such as redemption, all spiritual blessings, and the forgiven of sins? When is a person saved? Are they saved when they hear? Are they saved when they believe? (If this is the case the we have devils saved [James 2:19 says that the devils believed and trembled] and we have other men who did not confess Him being saved also {John 12:42-43}. Who believes this?) Can a person repent of their sins only and be saved? Can a person just confess that Jesus is the Christ and be saved? If this is the case then again we have the devils being saved because they did confess that Jesus was the Holy One of God (Mark 1:24). The devils are not saved nor are they in a safe condition; they are in a place that is prepared for them and that is in burning fire for all of eternity. If a person that is saved must do all of these things plus “have his sins washed away” (Acts 22:16). One is not included into Christ when they hear the Gospel but when they obey His commands (John 14:15).

The NIV also has in Ephesians 5:19 that all we have to do is “make music.” Now there is a huge difference in making music and singing. “Making music” can include a lot of ideas. Singing is a specific kind of music. “Making music” can include many different kinds of instruments, but the Bible mentions only one instrument, and that is the heart of the individual (Ephesians 5:19 KJV “Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord.”) Those who want to use the instruments have debated this issue for many years. They have tried many, many ways to have your Bibles read so that the mechanical instruments of music can be used. The Bible does not read that way and should not read that way. The passage should not be translated in the way that the NIV does. This is just a few of the reasons why I do not use the NIV.

Would you want to place your soul in jeopardy with such a translation? There are other passages that could be dealt with but this is sufficient to see that this translation is not to be trusted. These areas do and will affect the souls of those who use this mistranslated version of the Bible. Let us be careful and use an accurate translation of the Bible.

Let us be careful with our Bibles. Let us study our Bibles on a daily basis. Let us trust and obey God with all our hearts.
